Effective Date of New/Revised Requirements

Effective Date: **July 24, 2015**

Impact, Fees, Overview, and Action Required

Impact Statement: A review of all Listing Reports is necessary to determine which products comply with new/revised requirements and which products will require re-evaluation and test. **NOTE:** Effective immediately, this revised standard will be exclusively used for evaluation of new products unless the Applicant requests in writing that current requirements be used along with their understanding that their listings will be withdrawn on the Effective Date of **July 24, 2015** unless product is found to comply with new/revised requirements.

Overview of Changes: The previously established Effective Date of July 24, 2013 for paragraphs 72.1.1 and 72.2.1 has been extended to July 24, 2015. These paragraphs affect resistance to moisture tests for horizontally mounted controls and door switch flooding. Intertek had not previously announced changes to these paragraphs.

Specific details of the new/revised clauses of the standard are found in the table below.

Fees: So that production of products bearing the Listing Mark will not be interrupted, at some point between **5 – 10 months before the Effective Date**, our Engineers will begin reviewing your Listing Report (s) for compliance with these new/revised requirements. Either Listing Report (s) will be revised to show compliance or a Findings Letter will be prepared and sent to your attention along with a quote for necessary re-evaluation and testing. This initial review of your Listing Report (s) will be covered by a direct billing project and will be invoiced at not more than \$1000 per report.

Action Required:

Submit Information/Samples – The Intertek Engineer will identify what specific information and samples are needed to assist with verification of compliance with current production.

Current Listings Not Active? – Please immediately identify any current Listing Reports or products that are no longer active and should be removed from our records. We will do this at no charge.
